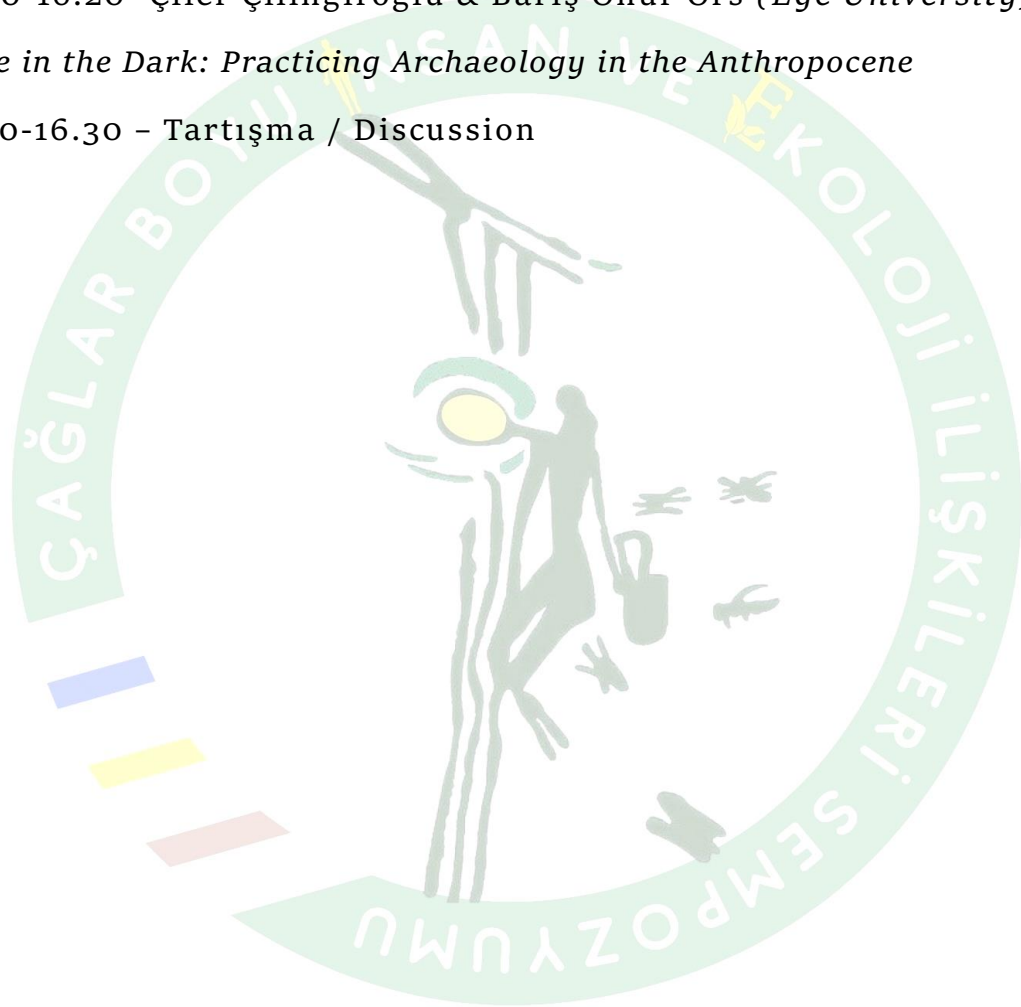

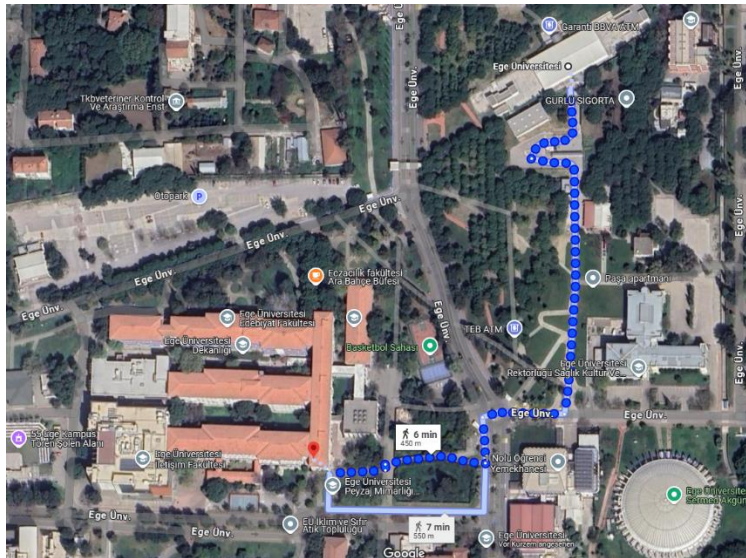

How to get to the Prof. Dr. Nuri Bilgin Conference Hall from the City Center:

The Prof. Dr. Nuri Bilgin Conference Hall of the Faculty of Letters is located within the Ege University Campus. If you are traveling from the city center, you can use the subway (*İzmir Metro*), or a taxi for convenient access.

By Subway:

1. Take the subway heading toward *Evka-3*.
2. Get off at the *Ege Üniversitesi* station.
3. From the station, it is a short 5-minute walk to the Faculty of Letters (*Edebiyat Fakültesi*), where the conference hall is located. Follow the campus signs or ask for directions if needed.



By Taxi:

Taxis are readily available in the city center and can take you directly to the Ege University Campus. Simply ask the driver to take you to *Edebiyat Fakültesi* within Ege University. The duration of the ride may vary depending on traffic, but typically takes about 20-30 minutes.

How to get to the Prof. Dr. Nuri Bilgin Conference Hall from Adnan Menderes Airport:

Guests travelling directly from the airport to the Conference Hall can choose between public transportation or taxi services.

By IZBAN (Suburban Train) and İzmir Metro:

1. Take the IZBAN train heading toward *Menemen* or *Aliğa*.
2. Get off the train at *Halkapınar station*.
3. Transfer to the İzmir Metro and take the subway toward *Evka-3*.
4. Get off at the *Ege Üniversitesi* station.
5. From the station, it is a short 5-minute walk to the Faculty of Letters (*Edebiyat Fakültesi*), where the conference hall is located. Follow the campus signs or ask for directions if needed.

By Municipal Bus (ESHOT Bus 204):

1. Take bus number 204 (*Havalimanı – Bornova Metro*) and get off at the last station, *Bornova Metro*.
2. From *Bornova Metro*, proceed to the Faculty of Letters by using the subway, taxi, or by walking.
